This Week's Focus

Phonics- This week students continued to focus on the /o/ sound spelled 'aw', 'au', and 'o'. We also did a quick review of plural and singular possessives.

Reading- We started this week by decorating notebooks for our literature groups which will begin shortly after Mid-Winter Break. Next week we will be discussing two of the tasks that will be required in groups.

Writing- We continued in our informational writing unit this week by completing a guided notes page on students' selected planets. We will use these notes to draft a graphic organizer that will help us to plan out the subtopics in each report. Ask your child to describe to you the subtopics they are thinking of using in their planet report.

Spelling- We will pick up with Unit 20 after our Mid-Winter Break.

Math- Students completed work in Chapter 7 by learning the rules for multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1. We will take the Chapter 8 pre-test and will begin work in this chapter after Mid-Winter break. Ask your child the name of the property that states that any number multiplied by one is that number.

Religion- This week that class focused on holiness and that everyone is called to be holy. Students learned that we can live a holy life by living out The Two Great Commandments. We discussed that in order to love our neighbors as ourselves, we must first love and respect ourselves. We read the bible story about Jesus cleansing the Temple of the merchants and money changers and then discussed how we can treat ourselves like a temple of the Holy Spirit.
