Manually Entering the PowerSchool Server Address in the Android App.

1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app. 2. On the Sign In screen tap Help or the question mark in the upper right corner. 3. On the District Code Help screen, tap Search for Your District. 4. Enter the PowerSchool server address in the field provided, and then tap Submit. 5. On the Sign In screen, enter your username and password, and then tap Sign In.

Manually Entering the PowerSchool Server Address in the iOS App.

1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app. 2. On the Sign In screen tap Where's My District Code. 3. Select Enter Server Address. 4. Enter the PowerSchool server address in the field provided, and then tap Submit. 5. On the Sign In screen, enter your username and password, and then tap Sign In.
