This Week's Focus

Phonics- This week was a review week for phonics. We reviewed diphthongs *oi* and *oy* and digraph *oo*.

Reading- This week the class focused on recalling story elements. We used our fingers to help us remember the five most important story elements. Ask your child to recall the myth of Pandora's Box.

Writing- This week students started drafting their first personal narrative. They rehearsed their narratives with a partner before starting to write, in hopes that it would then be easier to get their ideas on paper afterwards. Next week we will be working on writing interesting and captivating leads for our narratives.

Spelling- This spelling unit is a review unit of our past five spelling patterns. Students are in charge of learning all 35 of the words on the list that was sent home. There is only one list used for this unit and there are no high frequency words and no sentence. For the spelling bingo sheet students only need to complete three activities (in any order) instead of the usual five to make a bingo. Students must include all 35 words in each activity, except for the activities that specify how many words to use.

Math- This week students completed Chapter 1 and took the Chapter 1 test. Next week we will be working in Chapter 2 which focusses on how place value can help in adding larger numbers.

Religion- This week we continued to work in Unit 1 of our new religion series. We completed lesson 4 which focusses on the first three commandments and showing reverence to God. The class started lesson 5 which is about God loving all people in the world. We discussed the three theological virtues, faith, hope, and charity (love).

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
