This Week's Focus

Phonics- This week students focused on words that follow the vowel-consonant-e pattern. Ask your child why we refer to the *e* as magic.

Reading- This week the class continued to focus on recalling story elements. Ask your child to recall the tall tale *Johnny Appleseed*.

Writing- This week students continued to work on their first personal narrative. After students wrote down their first draft on paper we started to work on writing interesting leads that will hook the reader. Ask your child why it is important to write a good lead.

Spelling- The focus of our Spelling Unit 7 is the vowel-consonant-e spelling pattern. Both the challenge and regular list were used this week. Spelling Bingo sheets are back to normal, where students must complete one bingo to receive full credit for the assignment.

Math- This week students started Chapter 2 which is all about addition. Students learned about the three addition properties, have been using place value to identify addition patterns, and have used mental math to add two numbers together.

Religion- This week we continued to work in Unit 1 of our new religion series. We completed lesson 5, which is about God loving all people in the world. We started lesson 6 and discussed the difference between nature and person. Ask your child about the nature of Jesus.

Science- The class learned all about static electricity this week and the role that protons, electrons, and neutrons play in static electricity. Ask your child about the different charges that electrons, protons, and neutrons have.

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
