This Week's Focus

Phonics- This week students reviewed words that have consonant digraphs *th*, *ch*, *ph* and *sh*.

Reading- This week our class applied our knowledge of story structure to the novel we have been reading in class, *The BFG*. We read a chapter of *The BFG* and students completed a graphic organizer labeling the setting, characters, problem, problem-solution, and ending.

Writing- We completed our personal narrative writing unit this week. All students finished the last stage of the writing process, publishing, and we were able to share these narratives with the class. You can look forward to reading your child's very own published person narrative next week.

Spelling- The focuses of this week's spelling unit are words with consonant clusters and consonant digraphs *ch*, *sh*, *tch*, *br*, *nk*, *cl*, and *ng*. The regular list and challenge list were used again for this unit. This will be our last spelling unit until we return from Christmas break.

Math- This week students completed working in Chapter Five which focusses on division concepts. Students took the pre-test for Chapter 6 which focusses on multiplication and division. We will be splitting this chapter up into two smaller chapters. We will begin by working on multiplication and then we will move to division.

Religion- This week we continued to discuss the season Advent and how we can be peaceful during this season. Students also learned about the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy and how we can be the hands of Christ for others. Ask your child to name you one of the Corporal Works of mercy.

Social Studies- The class started Chapter One in our second Social Studies book. We learned about communities all over the United States and even about a community in Africa. Ask your child what "El Paso" means in English.
